

# New England Piano Teachers' Association presents A MASTER CLASS FOR PIANO TEACHERS

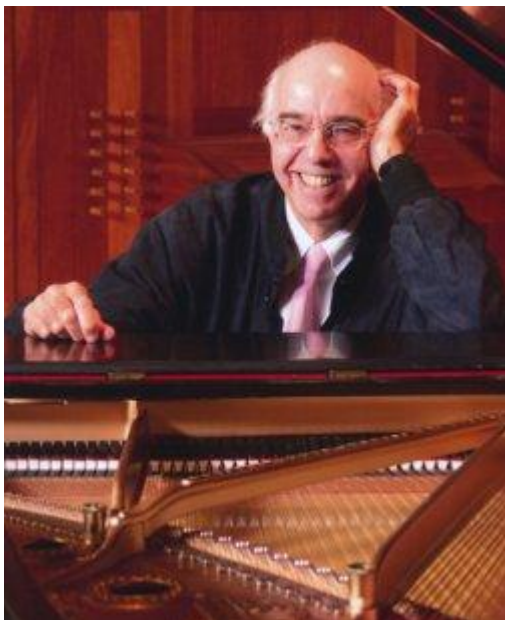

## Yehudi Wyner

In 2006 Wyner won the [Pulitzer Prize in Music](#) for his piano concerto, **Chiavi in mano**. It was commissioned by the Boston Symphony Orchestra, and premiered by soloist Robert Levin and the BSO in February 2005. Throughout his career, he has been a solo pianist, chamber musician, collaborator with notable singers and instrumentalists, director of two opera companies, conductor of numerous chamber and vocal ensembles in a wide range of repertory, and of course, prolific composer and teacher. Honors received in recognition and support of his work have included two Guggenheim Fellowships, a grant from the American Institute of Arts and Letters, the Brandeis Creative Arts Award, commissions from the Ford Foundation, The Koussevitzky Foundation at the Library of Congress, the National Endowment for the Arts, the Santa Fe Chamber Music Festival, Bravo! Colorado Music Festival, Michigan and Yale Universities and many chamber music ensembles including Aeolian, DaCapo, Parnassus, Collage, No Dogs Allowed, the Boston Symphony Chamber Players, and 20th Century Unlimited. Recordings of his music can be found on New World Records, Naxos, Bridge, Albany Records, Pro Arte, CRI, 4Tay Records, and Columbia Records. Professor Wyner's main objective is simple: to write the best, the most personal, and the most communicative music I can and to play the music of others with clarity and eloquence.
